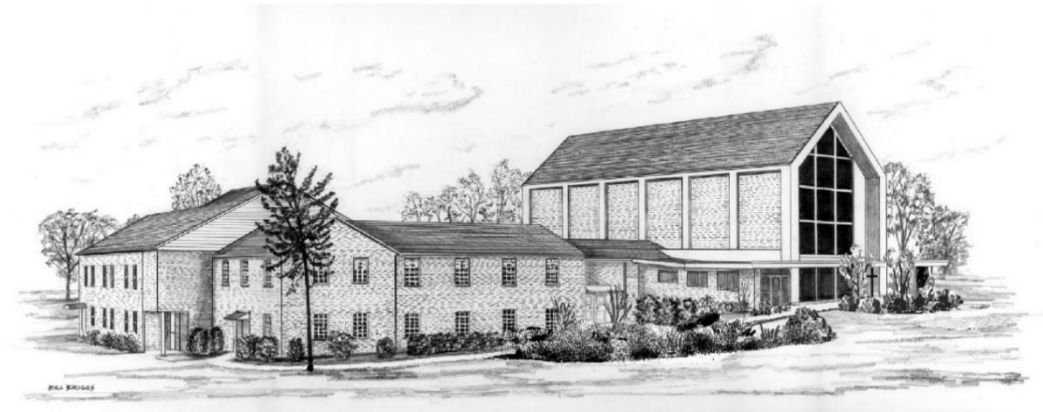


Dear brothers and sisters in Jesus Christ:
