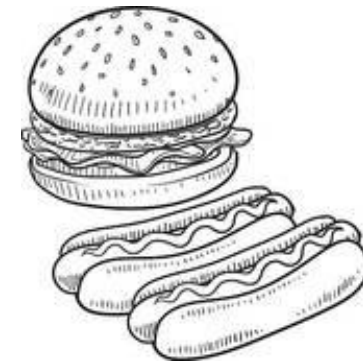
Volunteers Needed!!
