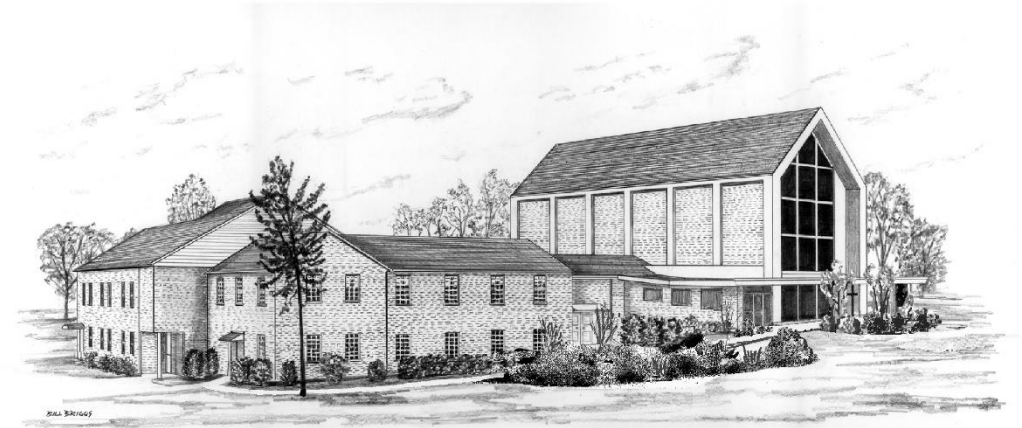

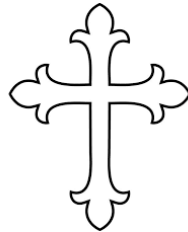

February Hunger & Help Offering

Second Harvest Food Bank of Middle Tennessee opened its doors in 1978 with commitment from several community leaders. The purpose of the organization was to provide a central distribution center for companies, groups and individuals who wished to help provide food for hungry people in Middle Tennessee.

Second Harvest's mission is to feed hungry people and work to solve hunger issues in our community.

Modeled after the first food bank established in Phoenix in the mid-1970s, Second Harvest was designed to collect food that would otherwise be wasted, inspect and sort this food, and distribute it to soup kitchens, pantries, and shelters serving the hungry. During the first year, this process resulted in a total distribution of 160,000 pounds of food to 75 member agencies.

Today, Second Harvest Food Bank of Middle Tennessee is one of the largest and most comprehensive of over 200 food banks and food distribution centers nationwide. During the 2018/2019 fiscal year, Second Harvest delivered 30 million pounds of food to 460 partner agencies, providing more than 28 million meals to hungry children, families, and seniors throughout the 46-county service area.

Money: the money will be used to purchase dairy products and to purchase gift cards to help families purchase gasoline and baby products.
