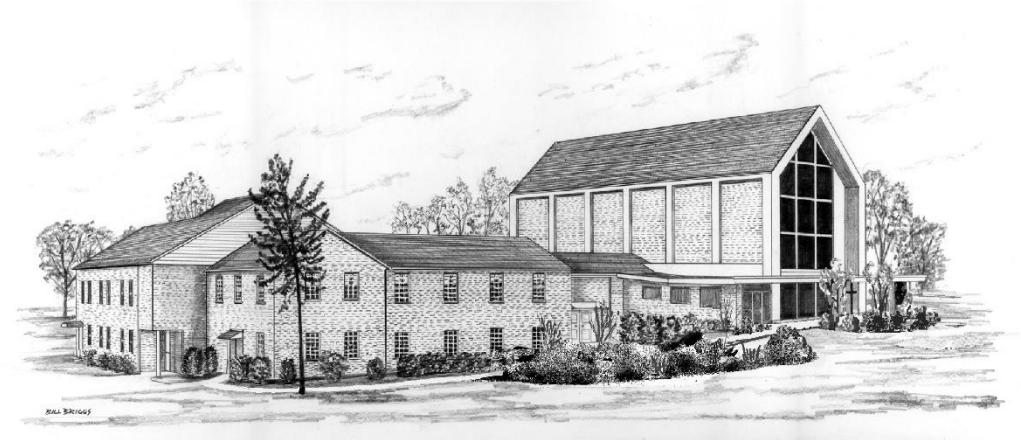

Set-up Sleeping Area: Lay out bed pads, make beds, set out toiletries and towels.

Evening Meal Team: Prepare hearty home cooked meal (to be served around 6:00 PM). Share the meal with guests, and clean kitchen.

Breakfast: Provide frozen breakfast sandwiches or other easy warm breakfast options. Items should be delivered on Saturday.

Sunday Morning Clean-up: Clean and return bed pads and pillows to storage, clean and setup class rooms used for sleeping quarters. Clean guest bathrooms and check TV (youth room). Everything needs to be in order by 8:45 AM. Becky Young has volunteered to wash sheets and bath towels.
