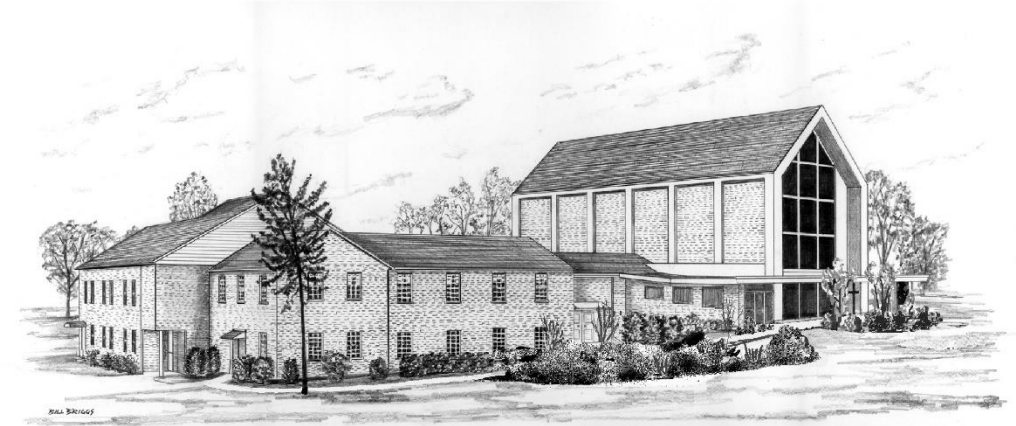
### **Worship Attendance Records and Wednesday Night Reservations**

We are starting a new way to record worship attendance. You will notice black books at the end of each pew on the aisle side. The person sitting at the aisle end of each pew should write their name and mark whether they are a member or a visitor and then pass the book down the row to the next person to do the same. After each person in the row has recorded their name, they will pass the book back down the row to be placed at the aisle end of the pew. As the book is passed back, we can see the names of any visitors and make an effort to greet them by name at the end of the service. The attendance sheet will be picked up after the service and used to record attendance.

There are also new green cards located in the pew slots for making Wednesday night dinner reservations. We will continue to use the green cards in the same way by completing the cards and placing them in the offering plate to make dinner reservations. **Set-up Sleeping Area:** Lay out bed pads, make beds, set out toiletries and towels.

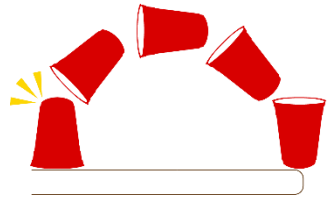
**Evening Meal Team:** Prepare hearty home cooked meal (to be served around 6:00 PM). Share the meal with guests, and clean kitchen.
