- 2) limiting announcements to those that are not already on the printed announcement sheet included in the bulletin

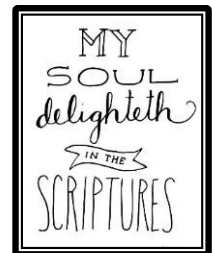
We'll begin this approach on Sunday, February 16.

## EDUCATION

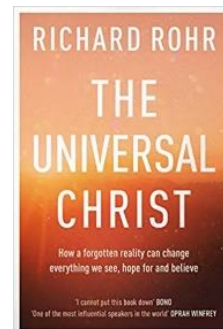
### **“Back to Basics” Bible Study – Wednesday, Feb. 5 at 10am (fellowship hall)**

### **Bible Study – Pericopes - Thursday, Feb. 6 at 7 pm (Schemberger home)**

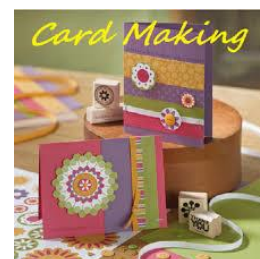

### **Card Making – Thursday, Feb. 13 at 10:00a.m. (fellowship hall)**

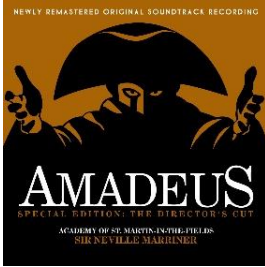
