#### With Al Galletly

Our one anthem this morning is entitled "Even When God is Silent" was written in 1988 by American Jewish composer Michael Miller Horvit. The piece was written in recognition of the 50th anniversary of Kristallnacht; the Night of Broken Glass that occurred in November 1938. The text was found by Allied troops written on the walls of a basement in Cologne, Germany. Written by a Jewish fugitive hiding from the Gestapo, the text is an extraordinary testimony of faith under horrible circumstances. The composer was born in Brooklyn, NY, in June 1932. He trained at Yale and Boston Universities, having studied with, among others, Aaron Copland, Lukas Foss and Walter Piston. For many years, he was a professor on the faculty of the Moores School of Music at the University of Houston.

# Stewardship 2018

#### "Nurturing God's Gifts for the Church and the World"

Wilton Presbyterian Church has a proposed budget in 2018 of \$473,000, which is a 2% increase from last year. To avoid the need for a fundraiser in 2018, we need to raise \$460,000 from the Stewardship Campaign.

We break WPC spending into 4 parts:

- \* Worship
- \* Caring for our Members
- Education/Community Outreach
- Hands on Mission

Here is where a portion of the money goes:

Caring for Our Members: WPC is one of the most caring communities around when it comes to attending to the needs of its members and friends. Deacons and staff coordinate many of the efforts of caring for those who need it. Much of this work is behind the scenes with love and grace. Whether it's visiting someone's bedside, or taking a hot meal, or offering a prayer, or a cup of coffee, WPC ministers to all.

Opportunities are provided regularly for members to nurture their faith through prayer services, men's and women's dinners or Bible Studies. Fellowship is encouraged through fun events such as game nights or our recent pot luck luncheon with our interfaith neighbors. New members are welcomed through classes and encouraged to assimilate into the life of the church quickly.

This month WPC will launch our new church website! Members and prospective members will know who we are and what we believe. Current pictures of church activities, fellowship events and service projects will help tell the story of our life together. People will be able to give and sign up for events online.
