Advent. The dawn of the coming of the Christ child. We begin this season of anticipation with "The Coming of the Lord" by Pepper Choplin. The rhythm of this spirited anthem, composed in 2010, suggests something very exciting indeed is about to happen as we prepare to celebrate the coming of the Lord. Choplin is a full-time composer, conductor and (of all things!) a humorist. He holds a Master of Music degree in composition from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary. Choplin is a member of Greystone Baptist Church in Raleigh, North Carolina, where he served as music minister for twentytwo years. Craig Courtney's "Who But the Lord" was composed earlier this year in honor of the retiring Director of Music for Christ Church Episcopal in Las Vegas, Nevada. A native of Indiana, Craig Courtney holds a Masters in piano performance from the University of Cincinnati. He started writing choral music in 1985, while at the same time continues his work as a pianist, a cellist, a vocal coach, an accompanist and choral director.
