Our first anthem today is the very popular spiritual, "Down to the River to Pray." Popularized in the movie "O Brother, Where Art Thou", this Appalachian-flavored spiritual is a genuine, heartfelt plea for prayer. delightful work that creates an old-fashioned revival mood, and is sprinkled with great fun. The version we sing today was arranged by Sheldon Curry, a graduate of Baylor University. Appropriately enough, our Offertory anthem is entitled "Offertory," a lovely piece with text based on Micah 6:6-8, one of the most popular texts in the Old Testament. The anthem was written by John Ness Beck, a virtual giant in the world of church choral music. Born in Warren, Ohio; Beck graduated from Ohio State University with a major in English. While in the US Army, he became increasingly involved in arranging for various musical groups. After his discharge, he returned to OSU, where he earned a Master of Arts degrees in music with a major in composition. He remained active in choral composition until his death from cancer in 1987.

This Week in Church School

We are exploring Mark 7:24-30, and there is one word that stands out about this story: unexpected. On first reading the story, the way Jesus is talking to this woman is unexpected. Why is Jesus comparing her to a dog? Then when remembering the culture, it is unexpected that Jesus, a Jewish Israelite man would speak or even listen to this person who is a gentile Syrophoenician woman. Any single one of those pieces of identity would prevent them from engaging with each other. Then in the story Jesus tosses out an insult at the woman and she doesn't rise to the insult, instead she responds with wit and tenacity. But she also calls Jesus "Lord" and this is the only person to ever address Jesus directly as Lord in It is all so unexpected! Despite all of the unexpected reasons they shouldn't be talking at all, Jesus listens to her and engages with her.

I wonder, who are the people who we aren't expected to listen to. Who are the people in our lives that we don't want to listen to? How could God's kingdom invade our reality if we allowed ourselves to truly connect with the people we aren't supposed to?
