

CHOIR CORNER

With Al Galletly

The choir will sing two anthems this morning, plus a familiar - and timely - choral benediction. "On the Road to Calvary" is from a larger choral work called "Olivet to Calvary," a seven-part cantata written by British composer John Henry Maunder (1858-1920). It was his only major composition. Born in Chelsea, Maunder studied at the Royal Academy of Music in London, and served as organist for a number of London-based churches, frequently accompanying concerts in the Albert Hall. Our Offertory today - "Jerusalem Rejoices" - was written by yours truly in 1977. It was originally composed for the four choirs at the Cathedral Church of St. Petersburg, FL: the adult Sanctuary Choir (which was the one Jan and I sang in), the College Choir, the Youth Choir (daughter Helen was in this choir) and the Children's Choir (Meg's choir). When performed there, the four choirs were positioned in different locations throughout the Cathedral, which provided for some fine antiphonal choral singing. The text of the anthem was written by Frank Kendon; except the verse three, which I wrote for the Children's Choir. Finally, the choral benediction today is "Were You There?", which appropriately leads us into Passion week ending with Christ's Crucifixion on Good Friday.
