

CHOIR CORNER NEWS

With AI Galletly

This morning's anthem features a very familiar melody written by Pete Seeger in the late 1950s. The lyrics are adapted word-forword from the English version of the first eight verses of the third chapter of Ecclesiastes. Seeger's song was originally released in 1962 as "To Everything There Is a Season" on the Limeliters' RCA album "Folk Matinee" ... and then some months later on Seeger's own "The Bitter and the Sweet". The song became an international hit in late 1965 when it was adapted by the American folk rock group, the Byrds. The Biblical text notes there being a time and place for all things: laughter and sorrow, healing and killing, war and peace, and so on. While the lines are open to myriad interpretations, Seeger's song presents them as a plea for world peace because of the closing line: "a time for peace, I swear it's not too late." This line and Seeger's title phrase "Turn! Turn! Turn!" are the only parts of the lyric written by Seeger himself.

The choral arrangement we sing today was written by Ed Harris in 1985. Harris was born April 24, 1943, in Forsyth, Montana, and later earned his music/music education degrees from the University of Montana and a graduate degree from the University of Washington. A nationally known composer, music educator and extraordinary man, he passed away in 2006, a victim of ALS, Lou Gehrig's disease.
