Hopson has served on the national boards of the Presbyterian Association of Musicians and Choristers Guild.

## This week in Church School

This week in Church School students will learn about Moses accepting God's call-the story of Exodus 4. Moses asks God how anyone will believe him, and God gives Moses three signs to show others, so they will believe. Then Moses complains that he is not a good speaker, but God sends Aaron with him to help. For every concern Moses has God provides and reminds Moses the God will be with him and will provide everything Moses needs, even the words to speak. Talk to your kids about moments in your life where you were reminded of God giving you what you needed when you needed.
