# Your Endowment Fund Hard at Work

You probably remember Nate Dove, the Yale Seminary student who interned at WPC last year? He assisted with worship, preached occasionally, worked with the Youth Groups, taught a men's Bible study and was an all-around helper and friendly face each Sunday. But did you know, that Nate's presence last year was made possible by grants from the *WPC Endowment Fund* totaling nearly \$3,400. This provided a stipend for Nate, plus a thank-you gift, his mileage back and forth from New Haven, and psychological testing required by Presbytery.
