Our first anthem today is "The Coming of the Lord", composed by Pepper Choplin, a full-time composer, conductor and humorist. He has gained a reputation as one of the most creative writers in church music today. With a Bachelor of Music degree from the University of North Carolina at Greensboro, he went on to earn a Master of Music degree in composition from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary.

"Every Valley" is our Offertory anthem. It was composed by John Ness Beck, who was born in Warren. Ohio, in 1930. He attended Ohio State University, where he graduated with a Bachelor of Arts degree in English in 1952. After several years, he returned to Ohio State, where he completed Bachelor of Music and Master of Arts degrees in music with composition as his major. He was a faculty member of The Ohio State University School of Music for seven years, then left the university to become owner and manager of The University Music House, a retail sheet music store in Columbus. He remained active as a choral director and lecturer at various musical clinics and festivals throughout the country until his death from cancer in 1987.
