CHOIR CORNER NEWS

Hey, we're on a roll here. Our first anthem is another spiritual, this one entitled "Lord, Listen to Your Children." The words and music are the work of Ken Medema, and the choral arrangement was written by Jack Schrader. Medema was born in 1943; he has been an active singer-songwriter performing in the United States, Canada, and Europe for more than forty years. He was born almost blind; his eyes let him tell light from shadow and see outlines of major objects. He began playing the piano when he was five years old, and later took lessons in classical music through braille music, playing by ear and improvising in different styles. In 1969, he majored in music therapy at Michigan State University. He lives near San Francisco, California, with his wife Jane. The arranger, Jack Schrader, was born in 1942. In addition to arranging, he is a composer, conductor, vocalist, and organist/pianist. He recently retired from Hope Publishing, where he was a senior editor of choral music.

Our Offertory is *"Grace Us, O Lord",* a composition by Joseph M. Martin, a choral composer who we have already highlighted several times. He is a native of North Carolina. His major works include nearly 40 choral cantatas and extended works, in addition to nearly 1000 church choral works, including today's anthem.

This week in Church School we explore the beginning of Jesus's ministry. After he comes from his time of temptation in the wilderness, he goes to Nazareth and reads from the scroll of Isaiah in the synagogue, and then proclaims, "*Today this scripture has come true in your hearing.*" People were amazed by his teaching, but then Jesus continued "*no prophet is accepted in the prophet's hometown.*" Eventually the crowd became angry and tried to kill Jesus, but he slipped through the crowd.

Sometimes we feel like we don't fit in even in our hometown. And sometimes people we knew when we are younger don't like who we are now. Jesus knew what that was like, but he still preached God's good news to people willing to listen. Talk with your kids about a moment in your life where you may have lost friends because of doing the right thing.
