CHOIR CORNER NEWS

The music for *"The Gift of Love"* is based on an American folk tune. The text is based on **1 Corinthians 13**, and this particular choral arrangement is by Hal H. Hopson, a prolific composer of religious choral music. He is a full-time composer and church musician; he lives in Cedar Park, Texas. He has over 3000 published works, and even at his age (*he is 86 years young*), he continues to compose on a regular basis.

Our Offertory anthem, "God of Great and God of Small", was written by Natalie Sleeth, another very noted (no pun intended) composer of religious music. Sleeth was born in 1934; she received her BA in music theory at Wellesley College in Massachusetts. An organist, she wrote nearly 200 anthems for church and school choirs. For many years, she was a member of the Highland Park United Methodist Church in Dallas, Texas. She died of cancer in 1992, at the age of 61.
