The Good Shepherd and World Communion

During Church School time, children will gather in the Upper Core for a Godly Play presentation. Using **John 10:1-18** (the Good Shepherd) and Psalm 23 (Holy Communion), our Christian tradition of scripture and sacrament will be told, using symbols to make meaning of our rituals. With these two images and stories, we can enter into religious language that is at its deepest, a core element of our faith. Godly Play is a Montessori method of formation that helps children experience the presence of God, creating an opening for the work of the Holy Spirit in their wondering and imagination.
