TODAY IN CHURCH School

This week in church school students will explore the story of the encounter on the Emmaus road (Luke 24:13-35). They have doubts and lost their hope, but during their despair they live out their hospitality by inviting this 'stranger' to stay with them. Then they recognized Jesus in the breaking of the bread.
