CHOIR CORNER NEWS

Our anthem this morning is called "Earth Song." It is a composition written in 2007 by Frank Ticheli. The text pays homage to the painful struggles of humankind in relation to our planet earth; finding light and hope through music and singing. Ticheli was born in Monroe, Louisiana. He earned a Bachelor of Music in Composition from Southern Methodist University, and went on to receive his master's and doctoral degrees in composition from the University of Michigan. Subsequently, Ticheli was an Assistant Professor of Music at Trinity University in San Antonio, Texas. From 1991 to 1998, Ticheli was composer-in-residence with the Pacific Symphony Orchestra in Orange County, California. Since 1991, he has been a Professor of Composition at the University of Southern California's Thomton School of Music.
