**Shannon is celebrating 30 years in ministry** – all congratulated her on this achievement.

**Rachelle** reviewed the new flock and contact lists, assignments for service, and book organization. She mentioned that new deacons should contact their flocks as an introduction.

**Cathy Thomas** provided an overview of our project to review and makes changes to the deacon function. She will be working with Rachelle and Shannon to compile a questionnaire for current deacons as well as former deacons for input before making any decisions.

The group discussed flock news. Rachelle closed the meeting with the passage from **Romans 12:9-12.**

# Session

We welcomed our newest members, Cathy Ratcliffe, Reshan Richards and Alison Wood, at our Zoom meeting on January 18th. Jason Rice updated us on the Stewardship campaign. Bryan Campbell will join the January 31st service and give us a further update at that point in the campaign.

Our finance chair, **John Burgdorfer**, reported that we closed out the 2020 calendar year strongly. Thanks to everyone, income from pledges surpassed the budgeted amount. As expected, plate income and sanctuary rental income were down but a generous gift of \$20K and the PPP loan more than offset these losses. Expenses for the year were only slightly higher including budgeted payment of the Presbytery assessment. **John will present the 2021 budget at our Annual Congregational Meeting on Sunday, February 28 th at 10:00 via Zoom.** 

**Jock Wright** and **Reshan Richards** have temporarily wired the sanctuary with a strong WiFi connection as we await vendor scheduling and ultimately a permanent connection. Make note for future reference that there are now two new network ID's in the sanctuary:

- (1) Most of us should select **WPC Sanctuary Guest** with password **wpcsanct** (all lower case) and
- (2) WPC Sanctuary Guest 5GMz that will be used only by leaders of services or meetings that are being broadcast.

**Berta Hull** asked for and received Session approval of a WEPCO capital project for repair to the bricks and roofing above Parish Hall. The WEPCO board has approved a quoted price of \$18,700 for completion of the project, WPC and St. Matthews each responsible for half of the total cost.
