A Whole Lot of Blessings

AFFIRMATION OF FAITH Portions of "A Brief Statement" PCUSA

- Leader: In life and in death we belong to God. Through the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit, we trust in the one triune God, the Holy One of Israel, whom alone we worship and serve.
- Left Side: We trust in Jesus Christ, fully human, fully God.
- Right Side: Jesus proclaimed the reign of God: preaching good news to the poor and release to the captives,
- Left Side: teaching by word and deed and blessing the children, healing the sick and binding up the brokenhearted,
- Right Side: eating with outcasts, forgiving sinners, and calling all to repent and believe the gospel.
- All: Unjustly condemned for blasphemy and sedition, Jesus was crucified, suffering the depths of human pain and giving his life for the sins of the world. God raised this Jesus from the dead, vindicating his sinless life, breaking the power of sin and evil, delivering us from death to life eternal.
- Left Side: We trust in God, whom Jesus called Abba, Father.
- Right Side: In sovereign love God created the world good and makes everyone equally in God's image, male and female, of every race and people, to live as one community.
- Left Side: But we rebel against God; we hide from our Creator.
- Right Side: Ignoring God's commandments. we violate the image of God in others and ourselves, accept lies as truth,
- Left Side: exploit neighbor and nature, and threaten death to the planet entrusted to our care.
- All: We deserve God's condemnation. Yet God acts with justice and mercy to redeem creation. In everlasting love, the God of Abraham and Sarah chose a covenant people to bless all families of the earth.
- Right Side: Hearing their cry, God delivered the children of Israel from the house of bondage.
- Left Side: Loving us still, God makes us heirs with Christ of the covenant.
- Right Side: Like a mother who will not forsake her nursing child,
- Left Side: like a father who runs to welcome the prodigal home,
- All: God is faithful still. Amen!
