Pastor Richard graduated from the University of Maryland in 1981 where he earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in General Studies and Special Education. His experience includes working with adults with special needs and Vocational Rehabilitation services.

In 2009, Pastor Richard developed Pivot Ministries' GED Tutorial Program. In 2010 - 2011, he was Project Manager for the City of Bridgeport's **GreenUp** program, a green-jobs training initiative, and in 2011 he was named Professional of the Year by the City of Bridgeport/Southwestern Connecticut Regional Workforce Development Board. In 2012, Pastor Richard received his license to minister, and in 2015 he was ordained as a Minister. Pastor Richard is an Elder of Stanwich Church and serves on the Leadership Board of Stanwich Church Stamford Campus.
