#### Quick notes:

- If you are unsure about how or when to trim a particular plant, please Google it! There are some fantastic online articles and videos on just about every issue a gardener could face. If that doesn't help, please email Kim (<a href="mailto:kgeneral83@gmail.com">kgeneral83@gmail.com</a>) and she will do her best to help. This is a work in progress we will figure it out together!
- Please dispose of the weeds and debris in the dumpster in the FLC parking lot.
- Please avoid "mulch mounding" (Too much mulch is not good for the plants / trees)
- Please avoid the use of chemicals.
- Please follow safety guidelines (e.g. gloves, goggles, etc.)
- Please avoid the use of ladders.
- We are guessing that people have basic gardening tools. If you need anything (tools, bags, etc.), please let us know.
- Cub Scout Pack 57 did a phenomenal clean-up of the Bell Island and Memorial Garden (Thank you Cub Scouts!). We are offering those areas for adoption because they will need to be maintained.
- The Trustees are in the process to acquiring more mulch. We will let you know as soon as we have a delivery date.
