The response was over whelming and everyone was excited to be a part of it and would like this to become an annual event.

After all the items were collected they were taken to the Hector Presbyterian Church where they were counted, weighed and organized for the food pantry. We are thrilled to announce that we collected over 400 items (approx. 350 pounds) and all of these donations will be given out at our food pantry starting in September.

We would like to thank the Haughey family (Jack, Pat and Cheryl) for coming up with this idea and their follow thru from start to finish. This project was a lot of work and coordination and with their enthusiasm it was a win-win for everyone!! Also, thank you to Ben and Marian Saks, Molly Schamel and Margret Swinnerton for packing up all of the donations and bringing them to the church.

We would like to make this an annual event and next year we will give everyone plenty of notice. We will also add an additional dock location where people who would like to donate outside of Peach Orchard can come by boat to drop off their contributions. In the future if you would like to donate food, personal items, pet food, or make financial contributions, you can drop your donations off at the Hector Presbyterian Church designated for our food pantry which is growing every year. There are more people than ever who are in need and anything that you can contribute will be greatly appreciated.

Again, we would like to thank everyone who helped make this project a huge success and we will see you again next year!

This will be a great annual event! But our extended Hector family doesn't have to wait until next August to help. Let's continue a tradition that goes back 2,000 years and bring donations to our food pantry on the first Sunday of every month as part of our Eucharist celebration. It's a way for us to share the love of God with our neighbors.
