Water Sunday incorporates a special offering that provides safe and Living Water for those in desperate need. By participating in Water Sunday, churches help save lives and build hope around the world. The Water Mission organization is a Christian engineering nonprofit that builds safe water and sanitation solutions for people in developing countries and disaster areas. Motivated by faith in Jesus Christ, Water Mission has provided access to safe water and the Living Water message of the Gospel to more than 3.2 million people in 53 countries.
