




**Loaded Up & Ready

Greetings everyone!

A blessed Holy Week to everybody. I hope that even though so many things have changed in the past several weeks, and many of those changes have been challenging at best, that some of that change has brought an opportunity to spend time with family, in prayer, and God in great and meaningful ways.

In the midst of all that is going on in our culture, our country and our world, our Session folks have established a way to reach out to others for whom these changes may be causing serious and life changing problems.

It is likely that most of us have heard about the government's stimulus package that will result in many Americans receiving funds from our government. In response to the current needs, the Session has voted to invite the congregation to contribute any percentage of the stimulus funds that we might receive to the HVPC Pastor's Discretionary Fund. Once received, this fund will be used to meet requests for financial assistance from HVPC members or others that HVPC members may know who are currently in need.

A team of three elders, with the pastor, will be responsible for receiving and reviewing each request for funds. The goal here is to help as many people as we can to move through this difficult time in the best way possible by sharing the love and blessings of God with any and all who are in need.

The Session will notify everyone, once funds are received, that the account is available to any and all who might benefit from it. As this is the Pastor's Discretionary Fund, all requests should be sent via email, phone or text to Rusty. Email: pastor@harborviewpc.org. Phone: (864) 399-2288. I will immediately pass each request to the review team, who will in turn prayerfully address the request as quickly as possible.

We ask that any donations to the Pastor's Discretionary Fund be over and above the donations and pledges that we have made to the mission and ministry at HVPC. We want to be sure that we are able to support each other and our community both in this way, and in every way that God calls us to.

Again, this is an opportunity to share with each other the blessings that have been shared with us. All donations and dispersals of funds will of course always remain anonymous. Please continue to be safe and in prayer for our community and our country in this time of tremendous challenge. I continue to hear story after story of how all of you are reaching out to those in need. Your gifts of meals, time, hand-written cards, prayer, and reaching out are bolstering the spirit of so many and giving hope to us all!

Thank you so much for all that you are doing! If you wish to make a donation from the

funds that you receive from the stimulus package, please clearly designate your contribution as Stimulus Gift. It will be immediately routed to the Pastor's Discretionary Fund and made available to those in need as soon as possible.

Virtual Easter Egg Hunt!


We are teaming up with other PC(USA) churches in the Charleston and Charlotte areas to hunt Easter eggs! Join us in the hunt!


VIRTUAL EASTER EGG HUNT
