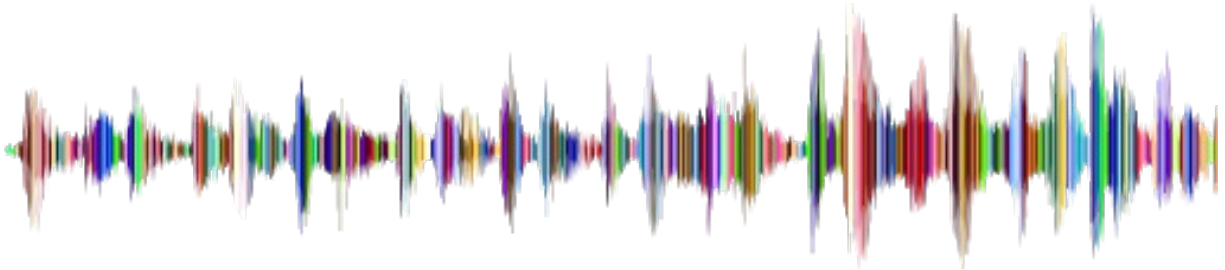


## Turn the Sound Up for Worship!

2020-2021 Sunday School/ Youth Group Offerings

To start this year we will be offering virtual Sunday School classes. Each class will send weekly/bi-weekly information in the newsletter to help you prepare for the upcoming class. Please check the newsletter weekly to ensure you have all of the correct information for the upcoming Sunday. All Classes will begin September 13th.

**Kindergarten & Elementary** - Each week members of the congregation will lead you through a Bible story, craft and song.
