

Evening Training of Sponsors in Preparation for a Weekend Event

LEGEND:

Italic type denotes elements of the real-life process.

Underlined type denotes elements of the role-played process.

Bold type denotes real-life liturgical celebrations; bold type underlined denotes role-played liturgical celebrations.

UPPER-CASE DENOTES A PRESENTATION ON THE NATURE OF CATECHUMENAL PROCESS (USUALLY RETROSPECTIVE AT THE END OF A 'PERIOD').

Sponsor Training is separate from the Training Event itself. Sponsor Training in this model is really a matter of recruiting half the participants for the Training Event (the eager half), and persuading them to recruit the other half from among their acquaintances or fellow parishioners; then, in the Training Event itself, the first group are the 'sponsors' and the second group the 'candidates' — except that they are candidates not for baptism (or pseudo re-initiation, as in many training designs) but candidates for conversion to a catechumenal ministry.

For this reason, although the 'mock' rites celebrated with the actors are the rites of the catechuminate, the genuine rites celebrated with the candidates and sponsors are rites of the already baptized — and these are adapted to celebrate stages of growing commitment to catechumenal ministry. And 'candidates' are invited to move into this commitment, but urged to go only as far as their convictions will take them.
