Statement on Ordination and Installation (Rev. Scott Huie)

Reaffirmation of the Baptismal Covenant (Rev. Huie)

Let us, therefore, reaffirm our baptismal vows, renouncing all that opposes God and God's rule and affirming the faith of the holy catholic church.

L: Do you publicly profess your faith in Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior, and recommit yourselves to discipleship in his name?

P: I do.

- L: Trusting in the gracious mercy of God, do you turn from the ways of sin and renounce evil and its power in the world?
- P: I do.
- L: Do you promise to live the Christian faith and share that faith in word and deed with others as the Spirit gives you opportunity?
- P: I will, with God's help.

Profession (Rev. Huie)

- L: With the universal church, let us confess our faith using the Apostles' Creed.
- P: I believe in God, the Father Almighty, creator of heaven and earth.
 - I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,

born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again; he ascended into heaven, he is seated at the right hand of the Father, and will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.
