Presbytery Congregations Awarded Mission Grants...

Six congregations in the presbytery have received funding for neighborhood mission grants in 2017.

- The McArthur Presbyterian Church received \$500 for a layette program.
- The First Presbyterian Church in Newark received \$3000 for the "Y-Healthy Kids Network" program. This program is a cooperative project of several churches in the Newark area.
- The First Presbyterian Church in Portsmouth received \$3000 for the Deacons' Food Pantry project.
- The Amesville-New England Presbyterian Church received \$1500 for Camp Counselor stipends for their summer camp program for neighborhood children.
- The Bremen-Bethel Presbyterian Church received \$2000 for a "Breakfast to Go" program for children in Bremen.
- The St. Andrew Presbyterian Church received \$800 for their Vegetable Patch and Bee Hive programs.

These grants are created to help congregations initiate new mission ministries in their communities. Although the congregational neighborhood mission funds allotted for 2017 have been awarded, new grants will be available as the presbytery receives additional mission funding.

Presbytery-wide Mission Work Trip Gatlinburg, Tennessee, October 22-28, 2017

This year's Mission Work team of 32 adults will be working in Gatlinburg, TN. First time mission workers are especially invited to sign up. Applications are available on the Presbytery website: For questions, email Jeannie Harsh: Jeannie@psvonline.orq. **Scholarships for Racial Ethnic College Students**: For college, university and seminary students who are minority persons, members of a Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) congregation within the bounds of the Synod of the Covenant, and in good academic standing. Scholarships are for one year, but may apply for a second year. Apply by September 1.

New Covenant Grants: These one-time grants, in amounts up to \$10,000 are available to congregations, institutions and organizations within the bounds of the synod that have formal ties to the synod. Projects must fit within the three mission priorities of the synod: Church Transformation and Development, Multicultural and Justice Ministries, Ministries in Higher Education. Apply by October 1.

Program Grants for Racial Ethnic Congregations: For racial ethnic and multicultural Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) congregations within the bounds of the Synod of the Covenant. Grants are for one year, but may apply for a second year. Ordinarily, grants do not exceed \$3000. Apply by October 1.
