- The Reverend Roger Au was elected Treasurer for the presbytery. Roger, a minister member of Scioto Valley, is currently the transitional pastor of the First Presbyterian Church in Logan.
- Elder Debra Bergmann was elected as the Ruling Elder Commissioner to the Synod of the Covenant, Class of 2017. Deb is the Commissioned Pastor at the Columbus Old First Presbyterian Church.
- Elder Richard Glass was elected the Chairperson of the Presbytery Coordinating Team, class of 2017. Dick, a ruling elder at the First Presbyterian Church in Washington Court House, will complete the term left vacant by Elder Ginny Shanda, who is moving out of the Presbytery.
- The Administrative Commission for the Marion Forest Lawn Church was approved to assume original jurisdiction in a situation in which the presbytery determined that the session cannot, or is unwilling to, exercise its authority. This Administrative Commission shall assume full power of the existing session which shall cease to act until such time as the presbytery shall otherwise direct.
