Columbus Hoge Memorial Presbyterian Church...

This Week's Congregation Lifted up in prayer.



Hoge Memorial Presbyterian Church, 2930 West Broad St., Columbus, was named for Dr. James Hoge, a pioneer religious leader in Franklin County and Moderator of the General Assembly in

1832. Hoge PC's first building was built in 1906 on Eureka Avenue on the west side of Columbus. The current church building, built in 1954, continues to house this mission minded congregation. Several years ago Hoge began a mission ministry (HM3-Music, Message and Meal) that has been vital to the Columbus west side community. Many congregations in the presbytery support and volunteer with this mission program. Hoge also houses and supports the Westside Urban Ministry (WUM), a cooperative ministry of interested congregations and the Presbytery organized in 2015. Covenant Presbyterian Church in Upper Arlington has developed a partnership with the Hoge congregation to provide pastoral leadership and administrative support.

While total membership in the PC(USA) continued a slow decline in 2016, a decline that dates back to 1965, the losses slowed somewhat last year. The number of adult baptisms reflected the highest increase in many years. However, the number of child baptisms declined in 2016. The number of candidates for ordained ministry increased, while the number of minister ordinations decreased.
