Herman Kumara, PC(USA) international peacemaker, has extensive experience in international development, project planning, and implementation and management of civil society and social movements. He conducts participative trainings for social transformation, helps with organizational development,

networking and advocacy for Civil Society/NGOs, and analyzes issues related to food sovereignty. He works with fisheries and small farmers, young people learning about environmental protection and members of women's movements to animate marginalized sectors to gain their rights. Herman is an advocate on land rights, ethnic and religious minorities, and women-headed families in war affected communities.
