Commission for Church Professionals (CCP)...

This commission is

responsible for the faith, training, health and vitality of those persons called to professional pastoral ministry.

Commission for Congregational Nurture (CNO)....

This commission is responsible for educational, connectional and outreach opportunities throughout the presbytery. The West Side Urban Ministry (WUM), a cooperative mission of the Presbytery, recently collected more than 700 coats and countless hats, mittens and scarves to help keep kids warm this winter. This ministry is staffed by volunteers of the Hoge Memorial Presbyterian Church on West Broad Street in Columbus. Seniors from the Columbus West High School and several other students assisted WUM with sorting coats to earn community service hours as part of their graduation requirements. The coats and accessories have been delivered to Elementary, Middle and High Schools. Coats were collected at the September Presbytery meeting and in a number of churches, including Plain City, Overbrook, Broad Street, Covenant, Hoge, and Westminster.
