Memorial Service for Elder Ruth K. Coons, Christian Educator and Past-Moderator of the Presbytery of Scioto Valley

A Service of Witness to the Resurrection for Ruth Coons will be held this Saturday, April 14 at 2 p.m. in the chapel of the Worthington Presbyterian Church, 773 High Street in Worthington. A reception will follow the service.

Ruth, who died in December 2017 at the age of 98, was an active member of the Worthington Presbyterian Church for nearly 40 years. Ruth's first vocation was in nursing before becoming a Christian Educator. Ruth served as a Director of Christian Education in East Aurora, NY and at the Broad Street Presbyterian Church in Columbus.

Ruth was the first woman Moderator of the Presbytery of Scioto Valley, and served on the Synod of the Covenant's personnel committee. Ruth was a tireless and enthusiastic volunteer in the church and the surrounding communities.
