Synod of the Covenant Mission to the USA (MUSA) Congregational Hosts are Needed for Visitors...

The Mission to the USA program (MUSA) links churches in the Synod of the Covenant (Michigan and Ohio) with international church leaders, both clergy and lay. Each Mission Partner is hosted by a congregation in the synod and joins in the life of the church. This fall the Mission to works in the life of the church. Meetings, just like worship, are a gathering of the people of God for the work of Christ's body, the church. When people come to both worship and meetings with open hearts and minds the Holy Spirit has a chance to inform and enable folks to do God's will. And we are reminded that it is the same Holy Spirit who informs us all. We are also reminded that this is why voting members are commissioners and not delegates. No one can tell us how to vote. We vote prayerfully and carefully after we have heard all the reasoning. Again, this leaves room for the Holy Spirit to work. So as much as there are other things I'd rather be doing and places I'd rather be, I've come to see meetings as the other place we do God's work in the church.
