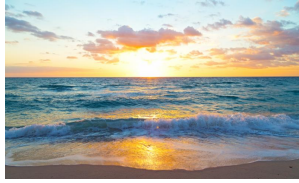

In the midst of important business decisions, learning about the denominational resources, ministries and missions, several hundred diverse Presbyterians of all ages took to the streets on a hot and humid afternoon in downtown St. Louis to call for social,

racial and economic justice. General Assembly participants, the stated clerk and many others joined other advocacy groups for the one-mile walk from the St. Louis Convention Center to the City Justice Center to participate in a "bail out." The jails are full of people being held on minor offenses, unable to pay minimal cash bail. The Assembly opening worship offering was given to the St. Louis Action Council to provide bail for persons who have been pre-screened for release. This 223rd Assembly is dealing with an abundance of decisions which will determine the future directions of our Presbyterian Church (USA). Take time to watch the business activities on the PCUSA.org website, and hold your brothers and sisters in Christ in prayer in this important time for our Presbyterian Church.
