Highlights from the 223rd General Assembly

St. Louis, June 16-23

For over one week, 538 commissioners and 183 advisory delegates from 170 presbyteries across the PC(USA) gathered together in downtown St. Louis to pray, worship, study, listen, advocate, make business decisions and discern the future visions for our denomination. During this biennial Assembly, the Way Forward offered fresh visions regarding power, control, decision-making and managing assets and resources. After discussion and careful consideration by the commissioners, a modest increase in General Assembly Per Capita was approved at \$8.95 for 2019 and 2020. This increase will continue to support our connections to our sisters and brothers across the country and around the globe.
