Offering now has a greater global reach, makes a more significant impact, and empowers participating congregations to use 25% of the money they raise on local and worldwide ministries of their choice. Mid councils retain an additional 25% for ministries of peace and reconciliation. The remaining 50% is used by the Presbyterian Mission Agency to advocate for peace and justice in cultures of violence through collaborative projects of education and Christian witness. The Peace & Global Witness Offering is received during the Season of Peace, which ends on World Communion Sunday, October 7.
