A faithful member bears witness to God's love and grace and promises to be involved responsibly in the ministry of Christ's Church." It then goes on to list 12 areas in which a member should participate. A real

Per Capita is the way we financially support and strengthen the connections of our work with congregations, maintain our theological identity and further the mission of the church in our communities and around the world.

General Assembly of the PC(USA) - \$7.73
Synod of the Covenant - \$3.25
