Greetings. The Presbytery of Scioto Valley of the Presbyterian Church (USA) is committed to supporting ministries to students in Higher Education within our presbytery bounds. The Task-Team on Higher Education, a ministry within the Presbytery's Commission on Nurture and Outreach, is commissioned to steward funding for campus ministries directed through the Presbytery.

We look to continue partnering with campus ministries through the provision of funds for the Academic Year 2021-22. Included is an application for your review. In addition to receiving your funding request, we feel it serves to help us learn more about your campus ministry and how we might be of mutual support. **Please submit this application to the Presbytery office by July 2, 2021.**

A note about our funding sources: The Commission on Nurture and Outreach administers grants funded from two sources. The first is funding from generous contributions towards mission from congregations within the Presbytery. The second is funding designated for campus ministry to public institutions from the Synod of the Covenant of the PC(USA). In cases in which a campus ministry is eligible for synod funds, it is also eligible to receive funding from the presbytery.
