

At our last presbytery meeting on February 19, 2019, commissioners voted on the changes to the Book of Order technically called the Amendments to the Constitution. You may find those amendments on our presbytery website: www.psvonline.org, under Documents and Resources/Minutes Archives/Proposed Amendments for February 19. We voted to approve all but 18-C, which we voted not to approve. As of this week, a total of

132 presbyteries have voted, and those voters have been much the same as ours. All of the amendments have been approved, with the exception of 18-C which was disapproved. That means a new Book of Order will be printed this summer and available to us next fall. For those of you who were commissioners to this meeting, you have had an opportunity to be a part of our national process of our connectional system of government at work. This is part of what it means to be a Presbyterian. Those of us who are members of a presbytery (Ministers of Word and Sacrament) or a local church (Ruling Elders) have a voice in the larger church. Thank you for exercising your right to have this voice.
