New Program with the PC(USA) Board of Pensions... Healthy Pastors...Healthy Congregations

The PC(USA) Board of Pensions is now offering a new program to help pastors and congregations work toward financial sustainability. This program combines financial education, consultation, and theological reflection. A one-time grant of up to \$10,000 is available to eligible pastors after the pastor and congregational leaders have completed an educational seminar, and the pastor has completed online educational modules, as well as financial counseling through Ernst and Young.
