# Staff reports

Received the resignation of the Stated Clerk effective September 30, 2019.

The Presbytery worshipped God, with a sermon entitled "Extravagant Generosity" by the Revs. Joel Esala, Jason Link, and Gray Marshall as the "Bad Calvinists" based on Matthew 20:1-16. An offering was taken for the Pentecost offering. The Lord's Supper was celebrated by the Revs. Lee Platt and Annie Melick.

Heard a report on the work of the PCUSA Advisory Committee on Social Witness Policy (ACSWP) by the Rev. Rick Nutt, member of presbytery and of ACSWP.

- Announced the upcoming merger of three churches on Columbus' eastside by a Plan of Union.
- Announced the Policy for Dissolving (Closing) a Congregation for 1<sup>st</sup> Reading.

## Commission for Nurture and Outreach:

- Endorsed \$3,000 Neighborhood Mission Grant for Bloomingburg Presbyterian Church associated with the Park Resurrection Ministry.
- Announced 35 youth and 9 adults going to Youth Triennium July 16-20, 2019
- Announced Synod PW gathering at Covenant Presbyterian Church, Columbus, July 12-13, 2019.
- Announced the Rev. Jimmie Ray Hawkins, Director of the PC(USA) Office of Public Witness, who will join us in the Presbytery of Scioto Valley for four days, September 14-17, 2019.
