PER CAPITA is the annual support that unites the nearly 10,000 congregations of the PC(USA), and gives each one of us the opportunity to share mutually in the work of the whole church. Through the support of one another, individuals are trained to become better ruling elders, ministers, and deacons of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.). Of each per capita paid, just \$8.95 goes to General Assembly (GA) to support and promote justice and mercy in the world as we continue the reformation of the church. This small portion of per capita, the primary source of GA funding, is used to come together in meetings and commissions, but also provides vital resources to disaster assistance, training, and the sharing of information with each of our congregations. As together we seek the mind of Christ, discerning God's call in our own lives, your per capita contribution shares the cost of coming together to discern the Spirit's leading for the future of the church.

This year the Presbytery of Scioto Valley (PSV) launched a new Global Mission Network to learn about the interests, passions, commitments and partnerships that already exist within our Presbytery and explore possibilities for new mission opportunities. You are especially invited to the 2019 New Wilmington Mission Conference (NWMC). NWMC is a week-long, multi-generational, mission conference held on the campus of Westminster College in western PA (one hour north of Pittsburgh). The focus is on youth ages 12 to 24, with programs for all ages. Last year 800+ people from 31 states and 19 countries were registered and 1,000 locals came to hear speakers. Ginny Teitt, pastor of Scioto Valley's Concord Presbyterian Church, serves as the current Director of the New Wilmington Mission Conference. Ginny is extending an invitation to all in Scioto Valley to attend the 114th year of this historic Presbyterian gathering. She has arranged a hospitality house for our Presbytery.
