2020 Presbytery Budget and Proposed Per Capita From the Presbytery Commission for Operations...

At the September 17 Presbytery meeting the Commission for Presbytery Operations (CPO) presented for first reading a budget for 2020 and the proposed per capita needed to balance the budget. Although budget expenditures from our current income is holding relatively steady this year, dramatic decreases in member numbers will necessitate an increase in per capita to maintain our united efforts as a Presbytery. Per capita needed for 2020 is \$45 per person.
