As the meeting convened, the Reverend Dr. Jeannie Harsh, Executive Presbyter, reflected on the life and work of former Stated Clerk Sally Robinson, and welcomed the Reverend Jeff Schooley in his new role as the Stated Clerk for the Presbytery. Jeff, also the pastor of the First Presbyterian Church in Marysville, addressed the body and expressed his excitement for his new service in the presbytery.

Christ's mission was celebrated with a sharing from the Reverend Cynthia Holder Rich on the partnership with the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA) in Tanzania, along with stories shared by the Reverend Joon Won Lee about the mission and ministries of our Columbus Korean Presbyterian Church.

Highlights in the Meeting including the formation of a

newly united congregation, the Unity Presbyterian Church, created by the combining of the Brookwood, Parkview and Covenant Parish Presbyterian congregations. The Unity PC will be located in the Reynoldsburg Parkview Presbyterian Church building.

#### Rose Run Presbyterian Church Congregation News Congregation Returns to its Church Home...



Rose Run Presbyterian Church

Rose Run Presbyterian Church, formed from members of the New Albany Presbyterian Church, originally began in 1999 as a part of the Presbyterian Church(USA) denomination with the help of its regional mid-council, the Presbytery of Scioto Valley. The congregation met in the

New Albany Elementary School and other locations in the community until constructing its church building at 5220 Johnstown Road in 2012.

In 2017, some members of the congregation decided to leave the Presbyterian Church(USA) denomination and affiliate with the Evangelical Presbyterian Church (EPC) denomination. Through the work of the Presbytery's New Albany Administrative Commission, those particular members and their leadership were dismissed to the EPC denomination and subsequently moved out of the church building at the end of August 2019. The remainder of the members began worshiping under a new name, Rose Run Presbyterian Church, in 2018 to distinguish its congregation from the departing one. Over the last year, members of Rose Run Presbyterian Church have been worshiping at several temporary locations. The new congregation will hold a special opening worship service as they return to their church home at 5220 Johnstown Road, New Albany on Sunday, September 22, 2019 at 10:30 am. Everyone is invited to attend this special service and help celebrate the congregation's homecoming.
