**News from the PCUSA Board of Pensions...***Healthy Pastors/Healthy Congregations Program*, November 18, 6:30 p.m.-8:30 p.m., Circleville Presbyterian Church

This program brings together pastors and congregational leadership to work toward financial sustainability by providing financial education, consultation, and theological reflection to help all build a brighter future financial together. A one-time grant of up to \$10,000 is available to eligible pastors after the pastor and congregational leaders have completed an educational seminar, and the pastor has completed online educational modules, as well as financial counseling through Ernst and Young. The program is paid for by the Board of Pensions and a Lilly Grant. The grant can be used for debt reduction or for retirement savings. For more details please go to <u>www.pensions.org</u> and look
