Presbytery 2020 Per Capita Update

Presbytery leaders and staff are very grateful for the continued congregational support and interest in submitting per capita for the year 2020. There are many of you who pay your per capita in full as soon as you are able. Thank you! We appreciate your payments and know that churches are feeling the strain of lower membership and higher expenses; the same challenges that face our presbytery.

Many of you have inquired as to what the 2020 per capita amount will be. The budget presented by the Presbytery Operations Commission for a second reading at the November Presbytery Meeting resulted in the budget being sent back to the Commission for Presbytery Operations (CPO) for reconsideration, with a reduction in the proposed per capita increase. CPO is working on the budget plan and will be presenting figures for approval during the stated Presbytery Meeting in February. Meanwhile, you are welcome to make a payment on your per capita, using the figure you paid last year. Any increase could then be submitted when the Presbytery has a 2020 per capita figure. Thank you for your continued commitment to financially supporting the work and ministry of our presbytery.
