Scioto Valley Presbytery Responds to COVID-19

As news of the growing and spreading of the dangerous coronavirus, we know we all must make difficult decisions in order to care for our nearly 15,000 Presbyterians in our congregations in the Presbytery of Scioto Valley. Earlier this week your Presbytery staff and PSV leaders decided to discontinue any face-to-face meetings, gatherings and worship, both presbytery-wide and within congregations. Many of you have received email letters with information and guidance for this time of continuing change and crises. Although the Presbytery Office is closed indefinitely, we will continue as much as possible to do essential presbytery work over zoom and conference calls. Although we are doing our best to work virtually and remotely, we continue to be here for you.

The Commissions for Congregational Life and Church Professionals are instructing all churches to suspend all face-to-face worship services, meetings and other gatherings indefinitely. All of our Presbytery Commissions are working together to provide information about best practices in this time, available resources, including guidance on video, Skype and live-streaming.
